- NOTICE OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER (required)
- FAMILY LAW FINANCIAL AFFIDAVIT (CHOOSE ONLY ONE) (REQUIRED)
  - FAMILY LAW FINANCIAL AFFIDAVIT (INCOME UNDER \$50,000)
  - FAMILY LAW FINANCIAL AFFIDAVIT (INCOME \$50,000 OR MORE)
- <u>CERTIFICIATE OF MANDATORY DISCLOSURE</u> (REQUIRED)
- ANSWER (2 OPTIONS) (RESPONDENT-choose only one of the options)

YOU MUST HAVE A VALID FLORIDA DRIVER'S LICENSE WITH AN ISSUANCE DATE AT LEAST 6 MONTHS PRIOR TO FILING.

A NOTARY PUBLIC. \*\*\* We can notarize your signature in the Circuit Civil/Family Law Department.

When all forms have been completed, please return them to the Circuit Civil/Family Law Department of the Jackson County Clerk of Court, along with your filing fee of \$408.00 and other fees. Your case will be forwarded to the Family Court Specialist for review once we receive proof of service on the other party. You may check back with a Deputy Clerk in 2 to 3 weeks after the party is served for the status of your case.

It is your responsibility to call the Circuit Civil/Family Law Department (850) 482-9552 to find out the status of your case. When the file is procedurally correct, a final hearing will be scheduled.
